Work Benches

On Thursday, Shed Member, Patrick Rafferty delivered an assembled bench and components to assemble two more benches. We are very grateful to Patrick for his generosity in donating the benches.

We plan to have all of our benches completed and operational within two weeks.

Veterans Affairs Grant Application

We were previously advised that we should receive advice on the outcome of our application well before now but are now advised that, due to the large number of applications, completion of processing of the applications could take an indeterminate time.

The plan was that funds from the Rotary Club of Karrinyup were going to be supplemented by the Veterans Affairs funds to acquire necessary equipment to get us to operational stage #1.

Rather than delay our progress any further we are now looking at using some of the Rotary funds to acquire items that will get us started.

Equipment

If anyone knows where we might acquire good quality used items please let Jim Barbas know. Otherwise we will look to buy new items :

1. A dual purpose Thicknesser / Jointer or
2. Individual Thicknesser and Planer/ Jointer

In addition to the new equipment, we already have installed a bench saw, wood lathe, bandsaw, various drills and hand / power tools.

We should then be in a position for you to engage in wood working projects. In the meantime there is still a lot of work to be done in organising the shed.

Work Aprons

We considered getting aprons made but Graeme has found good aprons at www.cargocrew.com.au If you want an apron it looks like they will cost around \$25-30.
