It is basic help for people who have never tried the art of scroll sawing. The two saws are of the highest quality and are available outside of shed hours.

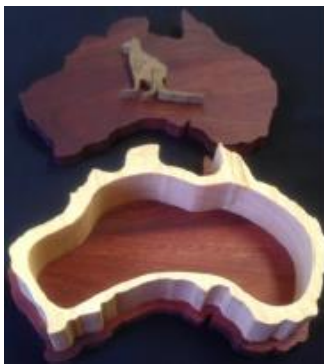
Saturday mornings from 8:00 to 10:30, Wednesday afternoon from 4:00 to 5:30
